

# Annual TLPF Golf Tournament Oct. 26, 2008, TPC Tampa Bay

## Golf Tournament

The Annual Gateway Insurance Golf Tournament to benefit the Taxicab, Limousine & Paratransit Foundation will be the first event of the 90th TLPA Annual Convention & Trade Show in Tampa, Florida.

## Times

The tournament will be held Sunday, Oct. 26, with departure from the Marriott Waterside Hotel & Marina at 11:30 a.m. and a shotgun tee-off at 1:00 p.m. An awards ceremony with dinner, drinks, and drawings for door prizes will conclude the event.

## Sponsors

As it has since 2001, Gateway Insurance Company, St. Louis, Missouri, is the tournament sponsor. Rich Kleinschmidt at Gateway is the honorary chairman of the tournament. BB&T John Burnham Insurance Services, Inc. and TaxiPro by AequiCap, Inc. are the banquet sponsors.

## Course

The par 71 Tournament Players Club (TPC) Tampa Bay course was designed by Bobby Weed with Chi Chi Rodriguez as player consultant. It was designed not only to challenge the top golfers of the world, but to also to provide a challenging and fun experience for players of all abilities. The course gives the players the opportunity to play well within their game, with a variety of teeing areas that allow the course to be played from 5036 yards from the forward tees to 6898 from the championship tees. Since being built in 1991, the facility has earned numerous accolades, including a four and a half star rating in Golf Digest's Places to Play. It has annually been voted the top golf course in the Tampa Tribune's Readers Choice Awards and has also been named the top golf facility in West Central Florida and one of the top five in the State by the readers of Florida Golf Magazine. The course is routed around natural wetlands, cypress heads and numerous ponds and lagoons, which are home to an abundance of wildlife. Deer, foxes, otters, armadillos, alligators, egrets, storks, cranes, blue heron, and eagles all inhabit the golf course. TPC Tampa Bay is the annual host for the Outback Steakhouse Pro-Am and operates according to the highest standards of operation within the golf industry, therefore, TLPA members will have the chance to experience what it is like to be a PGA Tour player!



## Dress Code

TPC Tampa Bay requires all players to wear proper golf attire. Proper attire for gentlemen shall include shirts with collars and sleeves, slacks, or golf shorts up to four inches above the knee. Proper attire for ladies shall include dresses, skirts, slacks, golf shorts, and blouses. Halter tops, tank tops, tee shirts, fishnet tops, cut-offs, bathing suits, sweat pants, jeans, tennis dresses, tennis shorts or other athletic shorts are not permitted. TPC Tampa Bay strongly recommends the use of soft spikes.

## Club Rentals

Players may rent clubs from TPC Tampa Bay for \$55 plus tax. Left-handed clubs are available. If you plan to rent clubs please check the box below indicating whether you play right-handed or left-handed.

- I plan to rent clubs from the golf club. I will pay for them directly on tournament day (do not send money to TLPA).
- I play right-handed  ; left-handed .

## Fee

The registration fee is \$135, which includes greens fees, golf cart, practice balls, two drink tickets at the awards ceremony, round-trip transportation from the Marriott Waterside Hotel and Marina and dinner. Twenty-five dollars of the registration fee is deductible as a charitable contribution to the TLPF. The entire fee is non-refundable.

## Prizes

The tournament will be played in a scramble format with twosomes playing the most advantageous ball after each has taken a shot. There will be \$1,500 in cash and golf-product prizes awarded. The winning twosome will divide \$300. There will be \$50 prizes for the "Closest to the Pin" on all four Par 3 holes. There also will be a \$50 prize for the "Longest Drive" on the par five 3rd hole. If you have a partner you wish to play with please list him or her below. Otherwise, we will pair you with a playing partner.
