Fees

The bowler/player registration fee is \$150 per person, of which \$50 is deductible as a charitable contribution to the TLPF. **The spectator fee** is \$125 per person, of which \$50 is also deductible as a charitable contribution to the TLPF. **The entire fee, whether a bowler or a spectator, is non-refundable.**

Tournament Format and Prizes

The bowling tournament will feature up to 16 teams with **up to 5 bowlers per team**. The final number of teams will be determined by the total number of bowlers who sign up to play. The final format will be determined based on the total number of teams. Spectators can cheer on their favorite bowling team or watch football on one of the big screen TVs. There will be **many** prizes for everyone – *even spectators* - including a variety of team and individual prizes, best bowling shirt(s), raffle prizes, and much more.
